It plays a critical role in ensuring an organization's financial health and strategic growth by managing resources efficiently and making sound investment decisions.

At its core, financial management involves key activities such as budgeting, financial planning, risk management, capital structure decision-making, and financial reporting. It helps organizations achieve their goals by ensuring the optimal use of financial resources, maintaining a balance between profitability, liquidity, and risk.

- Capital budgeting techniques: NPV, IRR, Payback Period, Profitability Index
- Understanding cost of capital and WACC (Weighted Average Cost of Capital)

Day 4: Working Capital and Risk Management

- Components of working capital: managing cash, receivables, inventory, payables
- Cash flow management and liquidity optimization strategies
- Financial risks: market risk, credit risk, operational risk
- Techniques for identifying, assessing, and mitigating financial risks

Day 5: Financial Reporting, Compliance & Strategic Finance

- Overview of financial reporting standards (IFRS/GAAP) and compliance
- Internal controls, audits, and ethical responsibilities in finance
- Linking financial management to strategic organizational goals
- Role of finance in long-term value creation and sustainability
- Capstone project: End-to-end financial plan and analysis for a sample business
